



MOUNTMILLIGAN

FACT SHEET: PROJECT OVERVIEW

Located 150 km northwest of Prince George, BC, about 92 km north of Fort St. James and 95 km west of Mackenzie, Mount Milligan will be British Columbia's first major metal mine of this century. The mine site is accessible by existing road from Fort St. James, as well as from Mackenzie, and is serviced by a 92-km power line. Construction began in mid-2010, with commercial production projected for the latter part of 2013.



PROJECT FACTS

- A conventional truck-shovel open-pit mine
- Projected to produce an average of 81 million pounds of copper and 194,500 ounces of gold annually
- Estimated 22-year mine life
- The mine will employ approximately 650 people during construction and 350 people during operations.
- Operator, Thompson Creek Metals Company, intends to fill as many jobs as possible with local candidates and will be providing training programs to help local people gain meaningful employment
- The mine will create a variety of jobs with different skills and training. Additional jobs will be required to provide service to the mine.
- As many jobs as possible will be filled by local candidates. Training programs will be offered through regional resources to help local people gain meaningful employment.

MINE PLAN

- The mine plan calls for an open pit mine producing 110,000 tonnes per day, with a mine life of 22 years.
- A 60,000 tonne per day processing plant will take the ore and process it into a copper concentrate. Concentrate will be shipped overseas for final processing.
- Proven and probable reserves of 482 million tonnes averaging 0.20% copper and 0.39 grams gold per tonne.
- Environmental Assessment and approval to construct have been received from the provincial and federal governments.
